I am writing to invite you to encourage pupils who are considering studying law (the LLB) in Scotland commencing in autumn 2017 to apply to the Lawscot Foundation. **The closing date for applications is 29 May 2017.** The application form is attached.

In order to be eligible to apply, pupils need to be able to answer yes to the following questions:

- Do you have an offer to study law (known as the LLB) at a Scottish university?
- Is your parental /guardian total annual income under £34,000 and /or do your circumstances mean you would be unable to attend university due to your financial situation? (This can include receiving EMA, free school meals, being in care or being a young carer).
- Are you currently at school, or have left school within the last 2 years (but not currently attending university)?
