2) Groupcall Text Messaging: As you know one of our main forms of communication with parents is through our text messaging system called Group call. We regularly send reminders for events such as Parents' Evening and this will be our main way of contacting you if the school has to close for any reason. However, we also send messages to parents for the following reasons:

➤ If your child has attended detention on that day or is due to attend detention the following day It is vitally important that we have your correct details in order to be able to contact you, therefore, if you change your mobile number at any time please contact the school with the new details.

3) Group Call Emails: Our other main form of communication is to send a group email to parents on a weekly basis with information about what is happening in the school. Please ensure we have your email address so that you can receive this information.

4) Consent Forms: At Perth Grammar School we run a number of trips out of school. These include trips for subjects, for example Science or Music trips, as well as a lot of PE trips for football, hockey etc. We would like you to complete and return the attached consent form by **Friday 26th August 2016**. This will be held on file for the whole year. Any trips which involve visiting foreign countries, long distance, for example Alton Towers or require different information from you will require another consent form to be completed.

You will still be informed of the trip by the teacher in charge, giving the same details as before, however, we are asking you to ensure that any changes in contact details, including emergency contacts, are given to us straight away so we can change our records.


