## **SPORTS TRUST GRANT**

Perth Grammar School Sports Trust was set up to promote, manage and improve the physical and mental health, fitness, wellbeing and education of young people in the communities that are linked to the school. They also provide or assist in the provision of recreational facilities which will benefit the local community. This grant gives local organisations the opportunity to apply for funding up to £500 to help with projects that lead to improved participation in exercise and sport and will have a lasting effect on the lives of the local community.

## **Application Procedure**

- 1. The application form can be obtained below and should be submitted to Miss Fiona Robertson, Headteacher at Perth Grammar School for consideration by the Trust.
- 2. Complete the form detailing your project
- 3. Submit form to the school office for the attention of the Sports Trust Chairperson.
- 4. The request should be submitted by the 1<sup>st</sup> of September, December, March and May for consideration at the Trust's meeting during that month.
- 5. The Sports Trust will communicate the decision to the applicant as soon as possible after the application has been considered.

## **Criteria for Award of Grant**

- Consideration for grants will be given to groups who are experiencing disadvantages.
- An opportunity has been identified that will allow the communities in the Perth Grammar School catchment area the opportunity to flourish in the area of sport
- There are barriers to this opportunity that have been identified.
- The group have the intention to continue the opportunity after the grant has ended.
- The group is willing to make an effort to raise some funding for themselves
- The group is willing to share their experience and participate in promotional material.
- There are clear positive educational and health and well-being outcomes for the opportunity.
- Other funding routes have been explored.
- A commitment to provide the Trust with evidenced feedback at the end of the project.
- The Sports Trust reserves the right to consider all applications individually and on their own merit and to review the grant awarding criteria.
