



### **HOW DOES IT WORK?**

Your apprenticeship will be planned to fit around your military training and relate closely to your role. That means that as well as becoming a better soldier, you'll be working towards a qualification that will also be valued by employers outside of the Army.

### **TYPES OF APPRENTICESHIPS**

Your apprenticeship will be on one of the following areas:

- Public services and health
- Engineering
- Telecommunications
- Animal care
- I.T.
- Logistics
- Construction
- Business administration

### **APPRENTICESHIP LEVELS**

There are three levels of apprenticeships on offer to soldiers when they join the Army:

#### **LEVEL 2**

Military trade training forms the main part of this level.

You complete a range of key skills qualifications (including literacy and numeracy), and get a technical certificate.

You will earn an NVQ Level 2 – equivalent to five good GCSE passes.

#### **LEVEL 3**

Advanced apprenticeship

Available for those in technical trades

You need 5 GCSEs at C or above, or a Level 2 Army apprenticeship

You earn an NVQ Level 3 - equivalent to two A-level passes

#### **LEVEL 4**

Higher apprenticeship

Work in real-time operations, countering real threats to national security, earning a Level 4 Diploma in Intelligence Operations.
