

# Modern Languages for Life and Work

Modern Languages Courses develop candidates' knowledge and understanding of a modern language and cover the contexts of society, learning, employability and culture. These Courses provide learners with opportunities to develop their reading, listening, talking and writing skills to help them understand

## S3

This course will provide an opportunity for those pupils with gaps in their learning from S1/2 Modern Languages to return to the faculty and complete the Modern Languages for Life & Work Award (Level 3) in either French or Spanish (class choice). The course combines short units of useful every day and transactional language, with the study of aspects of French/Spanish culture. Pupils will also experience aspects of the Building Own Employability Skills (BOES) unit which is undertaken in English. Pupils will further develop their literacy and communications skills, working both together and independently. They will further develop their knowledge, understanding and appreciation of other countries and cultures. All 4 skills will be studied but only listening and talking will be assessed.
