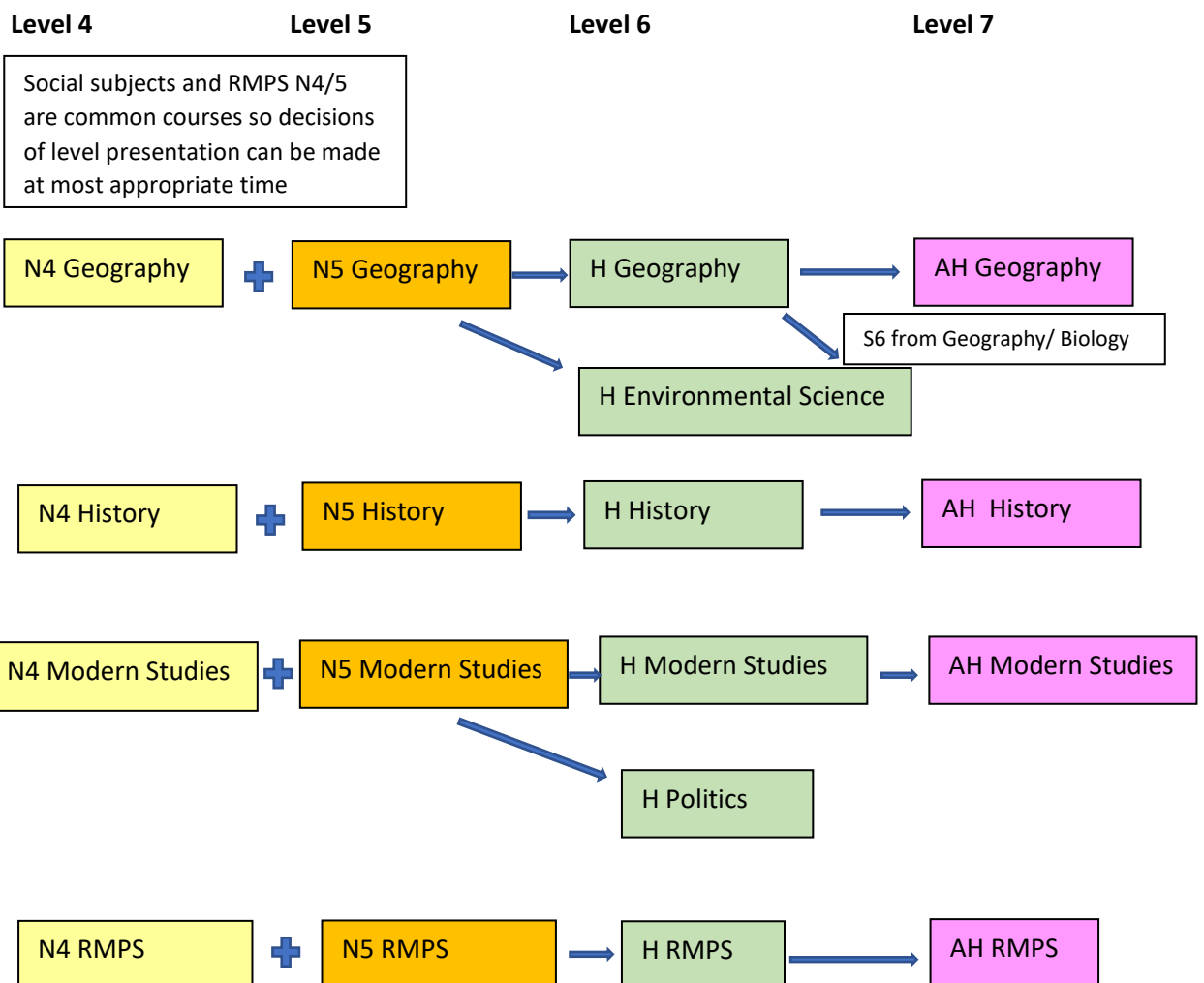
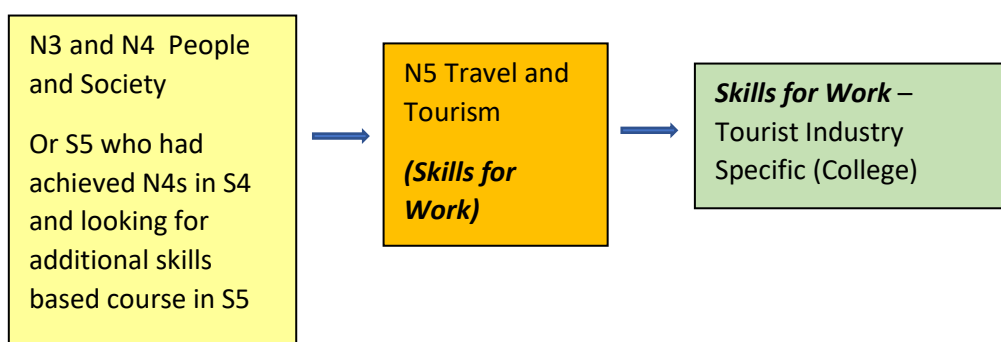

Pathways within Social Subjects Faculty

1. "Traditional" subject pathways = Geography/ History/ Modern Studies/ Religious, Moral and Philosophical Studies
2. "Specialist" subject pathways eg Environmental Science and Politics (more suited to people planning career/ further study in these subjects)
3. "Skills" pathways eg:

People and Society = Focus on key transferable skills within a pupil led framework

- Investigating
- Comparing and Contrasting
- Making Decisions

Travel and Tourism = focus on generic employability skills needed for success in the workplace. The courses offer learners opportunities to learn these skills through a variety of practical experiences that are linked to vocational areas.

Skills for Work courses help young people to develop their self-confidence. They also aim to provide a very positive learning experience. A chance to work on practical skills that relate to the world of work provides real benefits to learners.
