Senior Phase

Progression in History is available at N3/4/5 and Higher. At all levels, the course is divided into three units, with topic choices available in each section:

Historical Study: Scottish

Historical Study: British

Historical Study: European and World

At N4/5 and Higher, students also complete an assignment which forms a component of the final grade.

Throughout the course key transferable skills are developed eg analysis of different sources, research, evaluation and using evidence to draw conclusions.

These key transferable skills are valued in a range of careers or students may wish to go on to further study or specialised careers within this sector.
